Unlocking Potential Cohort 2	January - March	Identified students selected that are lacking confidence in their ability, thus falling short of their potential, carry out a 13 week programme of 1 hour sessions dedicated to promoting employability skills and emphasising the importance of a future.	15 students
1 to 1 sessions with potential NEETS	May	Individual interviews with the Career Connect Advisor for identified students from Y9 that are more vulnerable and need one to one support and guidance.	35 students
