Pathway 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Identifies and makes some comments on the differences between writers’ ideas and perspectives. 	<p>At the top of the pathway a student will: make comments on the differences between writers’ ideas and perspectives. Begins to develop a more informed understanding of writers’ perspectives. Can make comparisons of ideas and perspectives</p> <p>At the bottom of the pathway a student will: begin to make some comments on the differences between writers’ ideas and perspectives. Begins to understand and explore different writers’ perspectives. Begin to make some comparisons of ideas and perspectives.</p>
Pathway 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Attempts to identify and understand the differences between writers’ ideas and perspectives. Attempts to compare ideas and perspectives. 	<p>At the top of the pathway a student will: attempt to identify and understand the differences between writers’ ideas and perspectives. Attempts to compare ideas and perspectives.</p> <p>At the bottom of the pathway a student will: have pathway 1 and will have begun to make direct comparisons across texts.</p>
