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Registration

- A google classroom code will be sent to your parents via MyEd.
- You need to use this code to access your for Google Meet each morning at 8.30am.
- This will act as your daily registration and if you are absent it will be logged as an unauthorised absence.
- You will have the opportunity to type into the textbox and speak to your form tutor. You can ask them for any help and guidance you may need.
- It is important that you complete Sacred Time with your form.
- Following form time, you then must follow your timetable as usual throughout the day. Pay careful attention to staying safe online:
