

St Cuthbert's and Relationship and Sex Education

Guidance for staff and outside providers

The Catholic Church teaches that:

- Pre-marital sex is unacceptable. (CCC 2350, 2391)
- Marriage is a sacrament and is therefore a lifelong commitment. (Exodus 20)
- Only natural forms of contraception are acceptable, this is the rhythm method. All artificial forms are unacceptable. (CCC 2368 2370)
- The **purpose of sex is to procreate** and to take part in God's creative plan. It is also an **expression of love within a marriage.** (CCC 2362-2367)
- Homosexuality is acceptable but homosexual acts are not. Homosexuals should not be discriminated. (CCC 2358 2359)
- Self pleasure is not acceptable. (CCC 2352)
- Abortion is morally wrong and emergency contraception is seen as abortion. (Exodus 20, CCC 2270-2274, 2322)
- Fertility treatment with the use of a donor is unacceptable. (CCC 2374 2377)
