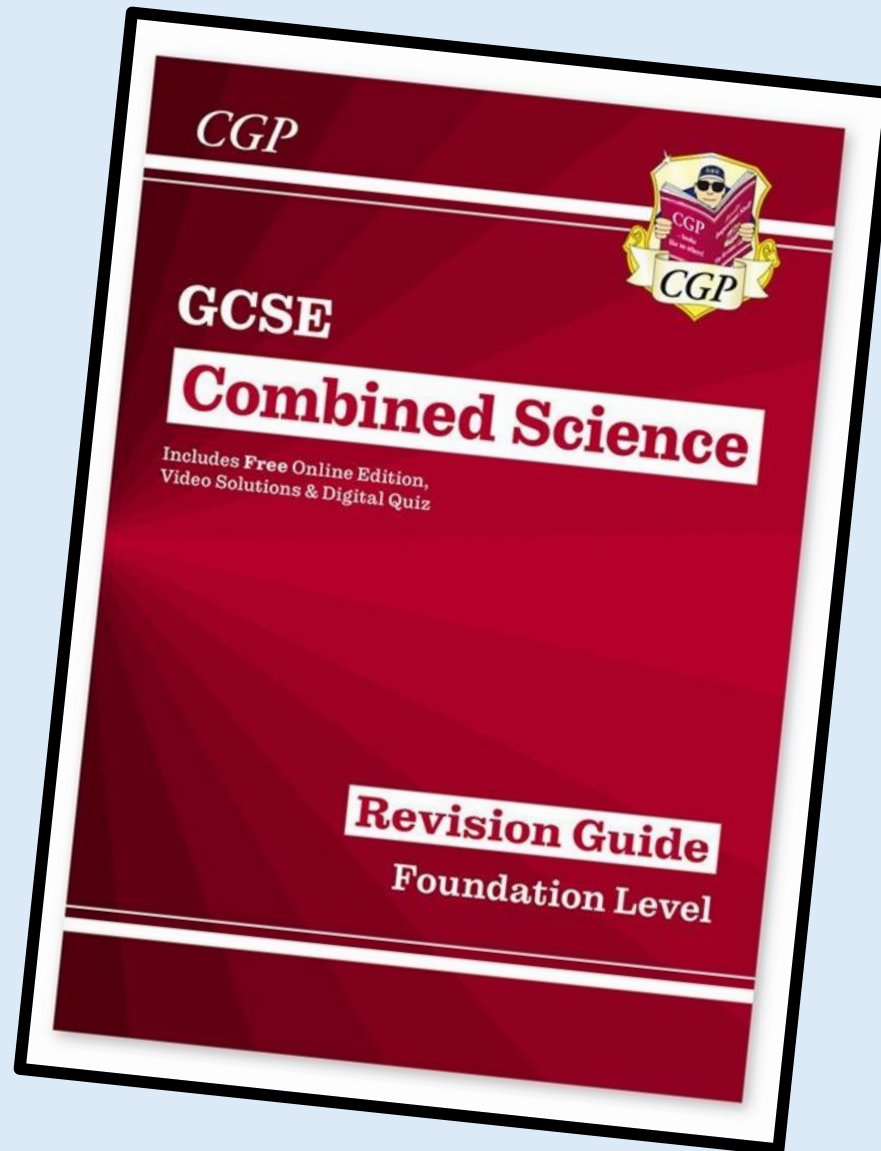

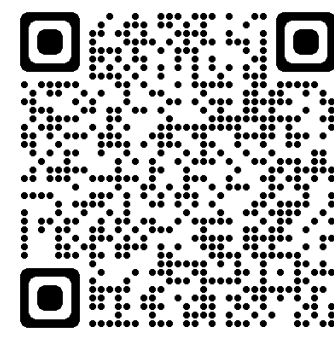

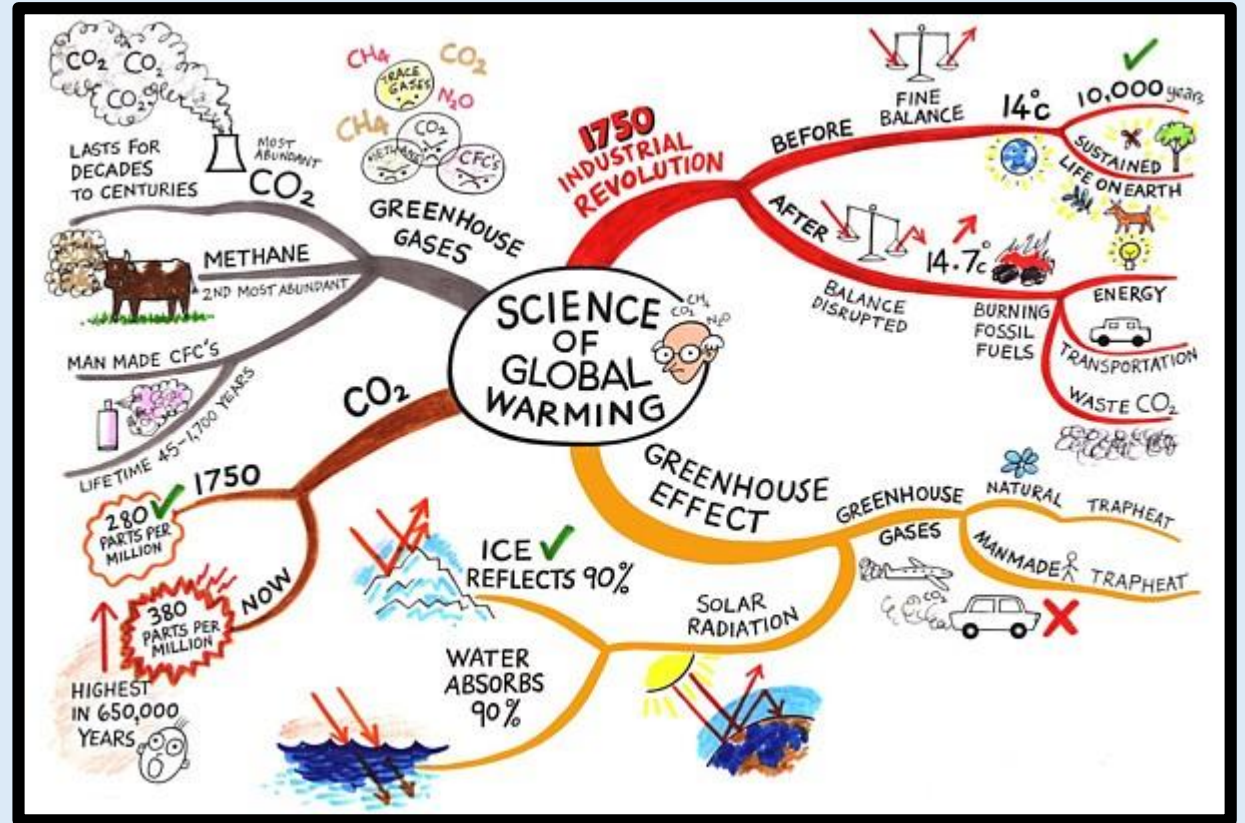

How do I use them?

Strategy number 1: Mind maps.

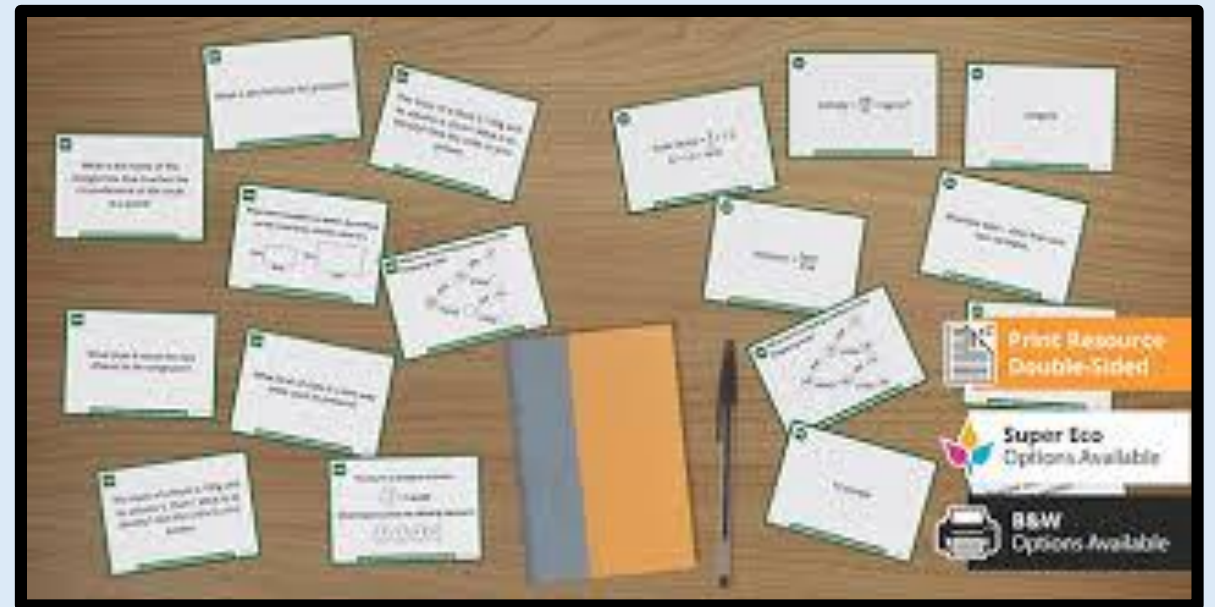
1. Add key content,
2. Write key questions and answer them another day.



How do I use them?

Strategy number 1: Flash cards

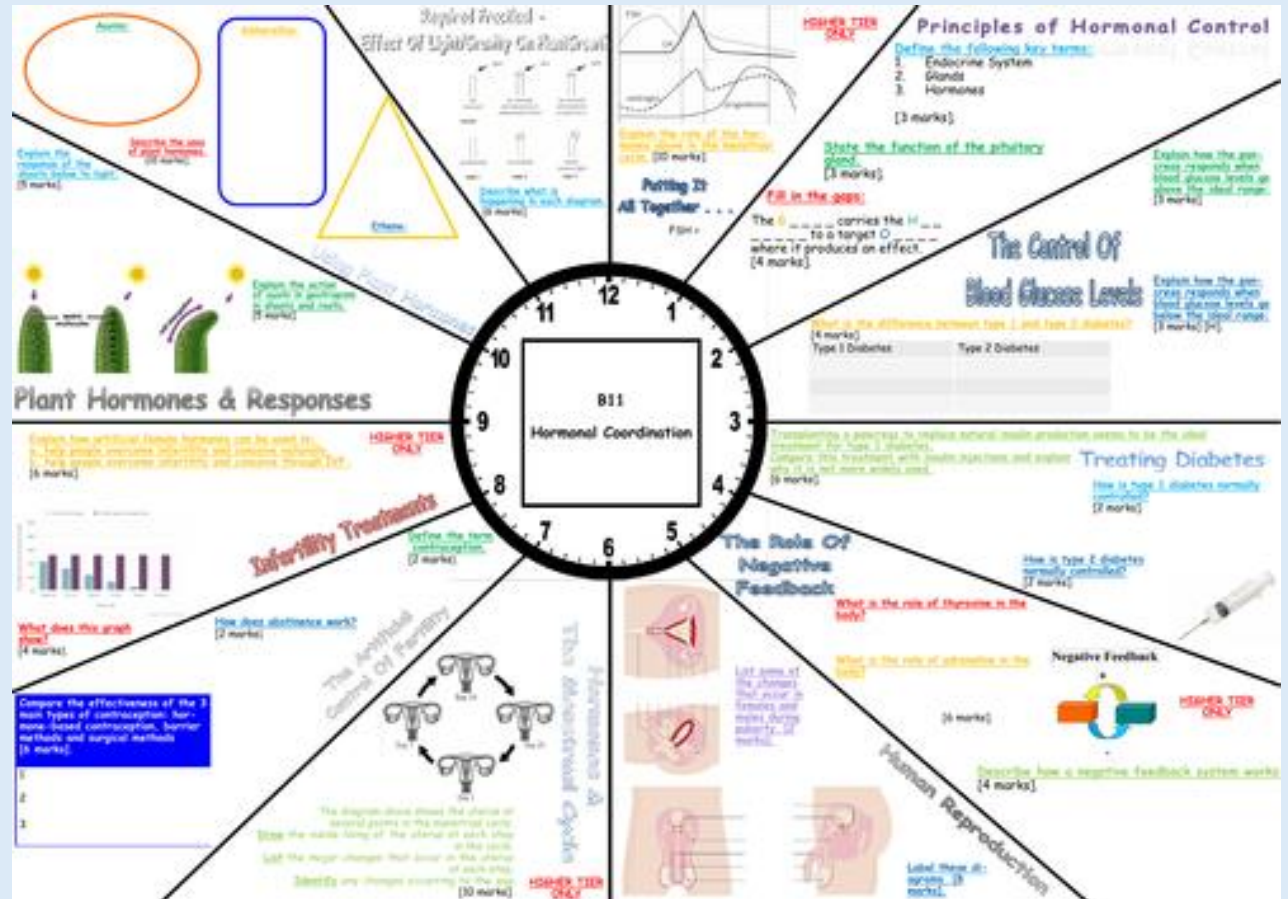
1. First side title of the topic or questions.
2. Second side the answer or the key information for that topic.



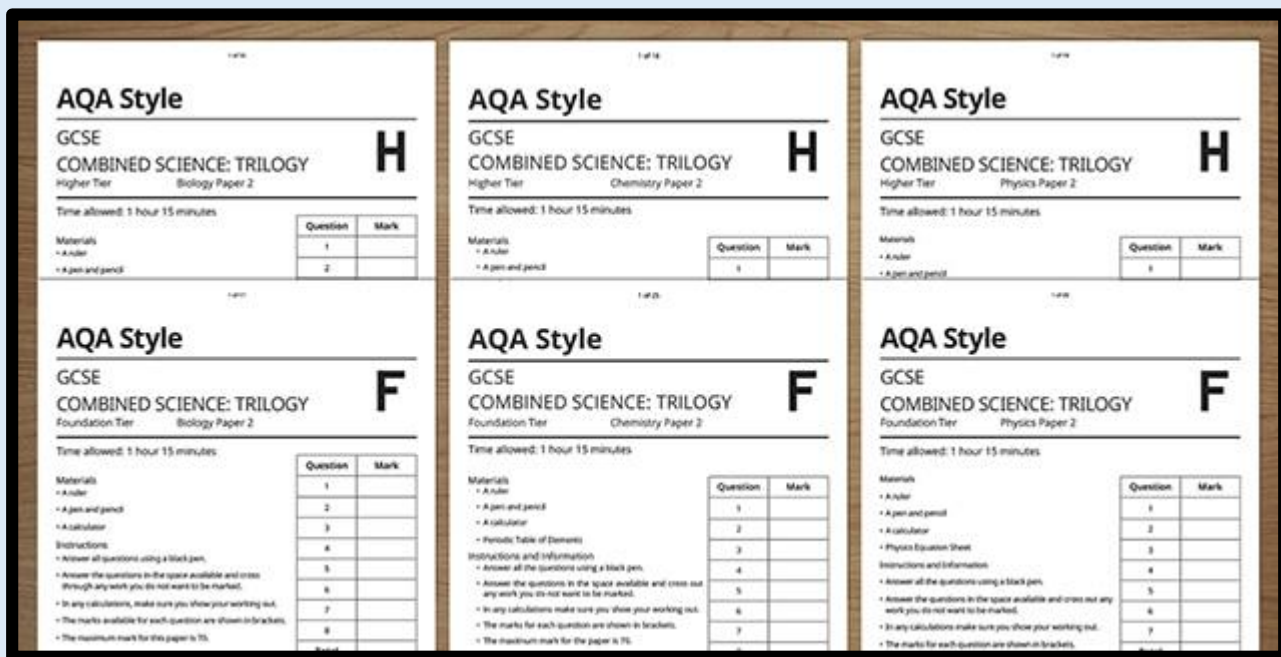
How do I use them?

Strategy number 3: Revision clocks

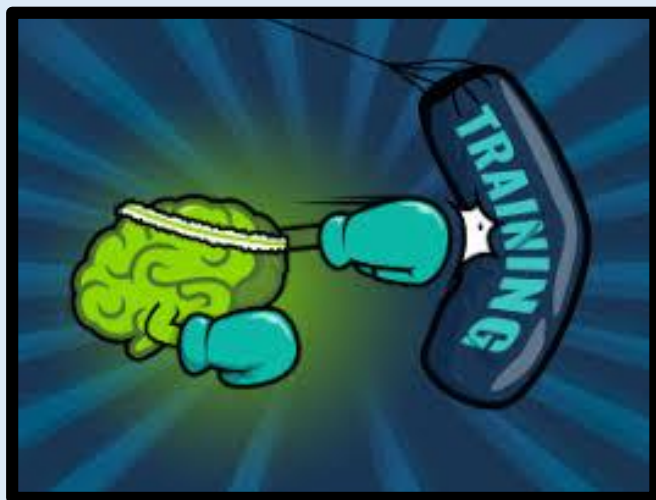
1. Key topic title in the middle.
2. Key information is short bitesize pieces



Reinforce your revision!



1. Similar questions most years.
2. Helps you to work out what you still don't understand.
3. Helps with exam technique e.g command words.



Finally, some key rules!

1. Do not just copy from your revision guide or exercise book, over and over again.
2. Don't spend too long revising on one topic, max 25 - 30minutes then move on.
3. Remember to have comfort breaks e.g. have a snack etc
4. Bring past paper questions you have completed back to your teacher so we can mark and help you in Science.
5. Start with the topics you are struggling with the most.
