PE Kit

I hope this letter finds you well and that you have all enjoyed a restful and enjoyable summer break. As we begin the new school year, I would like to extend a warm welcome back to all our students and families. We are excited to see everyone back, refreshed and ready for the term ahead.

This year, we are introducing a slight change to our daily routine concerning Physical Education lessons. To promote comfort and efficiency, students who have their PE lesson during Period 5 (the last lesson of the day) will now be permitted to wear their PE kit home. This will help ease the transition at the end of the school day and allow for more time to focus on other priorities. Of course, if students would prefer to get changed back into their uniform, they will be able to do this. If parents/carers would prefer for their child to get changed back in to full school uniform before leaving site, please let us know.

To ensure all students can fully access our curriculum, they must be in the correct PE kit. The required kit is as follows:

- Sports Top: Black polo neck with maroon stripes and the school Cs badge

- Leggings/Joggers/Shorts: Plain black leggings, joggers, or shorts (mid-thigh length)
