Mobile Phone Guidelines

Students may bring mobile phones for emergency purposes and to keep in touch with parents/guardians outside of group activities.

Phones are not to be used during meal times or group activities unless otherwise specified by the trip leaders.

Usage Guidelines:

- Phones may be used **during free time or when permitted by the trip supervisors** (e.g., to take pictures during sightseeing activities).
- Students are not allowed to use their phones for social media, gaming, or messaging during trip activities. This ensures that all students remain engaged with the group.

Safety Considerations:

- Students should not share their phones with other students unless directed to do so by a teacher or trip leader.
- Phones must be kept in a secure location (e.g., a backpack or secure pocket) when not in use. Teachers will be responsible for collecting and securing phones during certain activities to prevent loss or theft.
- We encourage students to be mindful of their surroundings and avoid using their phones in situations where it may pose a distraction or safety hazard.

Emergency Contact:

- In case of an emergency, parents/guardians can contact the trip leader or designated school contact.
- Please ensure that the school has your current contact information, as it will be used in case of an emergency.

Consequences of Misuse:

- Failure to follow the Mobile Phone Use Policy may result in the phone being confiscated for the duration of the trip.
- Repeated misuse may lead to further consequences, including being asked to leave the trip or restricted phone use in future trips.
