I wanted to write to you with a number of messages as we head towards May Half Term.

GCSE Exams

As you'll be aware, our school received a visit from the Catholic Schools Inspectorate on 30th April and 1st May. I have been informed that the final report should be with us on Friday 23rd May. New Pope

Parking

Mobile phones

However, we have had a slight increase in issues created by students leaving lessons to go to the toilet to use their mobiles whilst there. From today, if a student leaves lesson to use the toilet (which they should only be doing if absolutely necessary), they need to leave their mobile phone (switched off) on the teacher's desk until they return. We hope you understand and appreciate your support.
